\$3.4 Million Safe Haven Project Saved! Celebration & Progress Report Set @ 10 A.M. Friday

A celebration of and progress report on the \$3.4 million Safe Haven Project is set to start at 10 A.M. Friday, July 2 in Suite 205 of 254 College Street in downtown New Haven.

The event will bring together some of the community leaders, AIDS activists, concerned citizens and elected officials who helped win support from Gov. John Rowland Wednesday.

The progress report will show the steps between today and opening the first facility of its kind in Connecticut. Backed by a multi-million dollar grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Safe Haven Project will reach homeless people who currently fall through the safety net of state and federal programs. It will provide support regardless of mental illness, substance abuse, and HIV. status It will get people off the street and into a safe place to live.
